

ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 34-105
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEVILLE,
GEORGIA REGARDING ALCOHOL LICENSE RENEWALS**

The City Council of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia hereby ordains that the Code of the City of Lawrenceville, Georgia shall be amended as follows:

By deleting Section 34-105 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof, the following:

Section 34-105 Expiration: Renewal of License

(a) All licenses granted under this chapter shall expire on March 1st of each year. Licensees who desire to renew their licenses shall file applications with the requisite fee with the City Clerk on the form provided for renewal of the license for the ensuing year. Applications for renewal must be filed on or before January 31st of each year. Any renewal applications received after January 31st, shall pay in addition to the annual fee, a late charge of twenty percent (20%). If the license application is received after March 1st, such application shall be treated as an initial application and the application shall be required to comply with all rules and regulations for the granting of licenses as if no previous license had been held. If a license application is received after March 1st, investigative and administrative cost will be assessed. The establishment shall immediately stop selling alcohol and remove all alcoholic beverages offered for sale on the premises on March 2nd of each year unless the establishment has applied for and received a renewal of its license.

(b) All licenses granted under this chapter shall be for a one year period, and the full license fee must be paid without proration.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lawrenceville. Licenses lawfully granted for the year 2013 shall be valid until March 1, 2014.
