Minutes of the August 23, 2004 meeting were approved.

2004 SPLOST information was presented. Cities have a real interest in the sales tax event this year. The County and cities are in agreement on the local option tax that a portion will go to the cities. Lawrenceville will receive \$15,000,000 if it passes. This will go for urban parks, parking decks, support the cultural arts and enhance the downtown business community.

DDA members and publicly elected officials and members working for the various government agencies are prohibited from campaigning for the SPLOST.

LCI grants for transportation will be done by Brad Leonard.

Parking again was discussed as the main need for the downtown for events.

The next DDA meeting was set for Oct. 25.
