Mr. Merrill asked if the applicant was present. The applicants, Mr. and Mrs. Shanks presented their request for rezoning. They stated that they have been a long established

business and are looking to rent out the space they own in two existing buildings to new companies doing automotive type work. Their business, Shanks Welding is looking to relocate outside of the city. It was conveyed to them by the Planning Department that under the current BG zoning classification, each new business of an automotive repair nature would have to obtain a special use permit, as well as Shanks Welding, if they were to return to this property. Mr. and Mrs. Shanks fielded many questions. Mr. Merrill asked for a report from the Planning Department. Mr. Ferguson gave the report and recommended approval. Mr. Merrill asked if there was any opposition. Mr. Jerry Moore spoke asking for clarification as to whether or not the rezoning would affect the entire property in question, or just certain buildings on the property. It was conveyed to him that the rezoning would affect the entire property in question. Mr. Smith then made a motion for approval which was seconded by Mr. Moore. The motion carried. 3-0
