NEW BUSINESS

1. Amendment to Zoning Ordinance **Article X Signs**
Electronic Message Centers

Mr. Merrill called on Dennis Billew to give the presentation from the Planning Department.

Mr. Billew stated that he spent time researching the plans of other municipalities as well as holding meetings with representatives in the sign industry prior to his proposal of the ordinance amendment. Mr. Billew invited two representatives of the sign industry, Mr. Mike Reedy and Mr. Eric Johansen to be involved in the Planning Commission discussion of the amendment. Mr. Reedy, who is also a member of the Lawrenceville Downtown Development Authority, would also give input from the Authority's perspective.

Mr. Billew stated that if it pleased the Commissioners, it was his desire was to read through each proposed change and discuss in an open format. Mr. Merrill agreed.

Mr. Billew read the sections to be amended. After much discussion, Mr. Merrill called on Mr. Reedy to give the pleasure of the LDDA. Mr. Reedy stated the LDDA wished to restrict the use of EMC's in the 9 block area of downtown only to Civic and Not-for-profit applicants. The Planning Commission members made additions and deletions to the amendment and asked Mr. Billew to present a revised ordinance at the January meeting.

Mr. Merrill entertained a motion to adjourn. Mr. Roberts made a motion for adjournment. Mr. Moore seconded the motion. The motion carried. 4-0
