

Mayor Sikes called the Special Call meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. with all Council Members present.

Mr. Powell presented the bids for the demolition of the structure located at 37 Herbert Hayes Drive. Mr. Powell stated that this location has gone through the City's Nuisance Complaint process and the owners have neglected to make the necessary repairs to bring the house to code. He asked that the council approve the demolition of this property and a lien being placed against the property so that the City can recoup their funds. Mr. Powell listed the bids:
