

Mayor Sikes called the Special Call meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. with all council members present.

Mayor Sikes called on Mr. Powell to present the first reading of proposed zoning changes on classifications on mini warehouses, all uses involving automobile care industry, handwriting analysis, fortune telling, tools and machine shops, motels, motor hotels and extended stay hotels, and peddlers. Mr. Powell presented the changes in a handout. Mr. Martin made a motion to table action on this matter. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

Mr. Powell then presented the second reading of the amendments to the ordinances affecting the quality of life unit. Mr. Powell stated that these items are listed as item 2 in the handout and that the changes are highlighted. Mr. Powell stated that if all the amendments are approved, the Quality of Life unit should be in place by March 1, 2006. Mr. Clark made a motion to approve the Quality of Life unit. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Clark asked that monthly reports be given to the council and that the document should be amended as such.

Mr. Martin made a motion to approve the amendments to Ordinance Chapter 21. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Clark then made a motion to approve the amendments to Article XVI of the City's Zoning Ordinance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Martin made a motion to add Chapter 49 to the City Code of Ordinance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

There being no further business, the Council adjourned into the Work Session.
