

Mayor Millsaps called the Public Hearing and Special Call meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. with all Council Members present.

Mayor Millsaps stated that the first item of business is the public hearing to determine the 2007 millage rate. The public hearing was recently advertised in the Gwinnett legal organ. Mr. Baroni stated that the proposed millage rate for this year is 2.2 mills. He stated that this millage rate would not create a tax increase and should be revenue neutral. Mayor Millsaps then asked for any public discussion. There was none. The matter was placed on the Special Call meeting for a vote under New Business.

Mayor Millsaps called on Mr. Tony Powell to present the second reading of the Alcohol Ordinance Amendment. Mr. Crow made a motion that this be tabled until the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

Mayor Millsaps then called on Mr. Powell to present the second reading of the Animal Control Ordinance Amendment. Mr. Powell explained the amendment. Mr. Crow made a motion to table this matter until the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

Mr. Powell also presented the second reading of the Taxi Cab Ordinance Amendment. After some discussion, Dr. Johnson made a motion to table this matter until the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

Mr. Baroni presented the advertisement and proposed millage rate for next year. Mr. Baroni asked that the millage rate be set at 2.2 mills. Mr. Martin made a motion to set the millage rate at 2.2 mills. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

There being no further business, Mr. Martin made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Dr. Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.
