

Mayor Millsaps called the Special Call meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. with all Council Members present except Dr. Johnson who was out of town.

PUBLIC HEARING – OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Larry Genn presented the second reading of the rezoning request for the property located at 846 North Clayton Street. Mr. Genn stated that he is requesting that the zoning be changed from RS150 to O&I. Mr. Martin made a motion to approve the rezoning request with the following stipulations: a fence placed on all sides facing residential zoning; no metal facades; a 15' landscape buffer on the south side; and a 10' landscape buffer on the residential side. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Powell presented the second reading of the Animal Control Ordinance. Mr. Crow made a motion to approve the ordinance as amended with two changes:

Page 12: Delete the section "At the time of registration...notice of cancellation of policy" and

Page 4, Section D(1) should read "owners or custodians of any guard or watch dogs must confine all dogs within a perimeter fence and meet the following conditions:".

The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

NEW BUSINESS

Chief Johnson presented the first reading of the Speed Zone Ordinance from the State Department of Transportation. Mr. Martin made a motion to proceed to the second reading of the Speed Zone Ordinance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

There being no further business, Mr. Crow made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously.
