

Mayor Millsaps called the July City Council meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with all Council Members present.

Mayor Millsaps called for the reading of the June 7, 2010 City Council minutes. Ms. Smith made a motion to approve the minutes as recorded. The motion was seconded by Mr. Crow. The motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS – OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Matt Benson presented the second reading of the revisions to the City's Alcohol Ordinance. After the presentation, Mr. Martin made a motion to approve the amendments to the Alcohol Ordinance with an additional amendment to Article 3, 91(e)-1 requesting that the seating capacity be reduced from 60 seats to 50 seats. The motion was seconded by Mr. Crow. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

Mr. Benson also presented the second reading of the Soil Erosion Ordinance. After the presentation, Mr. Crow made a motion to approve the ordinance as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS – NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Millsaps stated that the City received a request from the pastor of the First Hispanic Baptist Church asking that their rezoning application be withdrawn. Mr. Crow made a motion to allow for the withdrawal of the zoning application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Smith. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

COUNCIL BUSINESS MEETING – NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Millsaps read a portion of the City Council Resolution opposing the commercial expansion of Briscoe Field. After Mr. Millsaps' presentation, Mr. Crow made a motion to approve the resolution. The motion was seconded by Ms. Beiser. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

Captain Smith presented an application for a Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$17,703.00. Mr. Crow made a motion to approve the grant application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Beiser. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. David Jones, 1242 Daniel Lane spoke on behalf of the LNA, and asked that the

council give a higher priority to nuisance complaints. A grid of Quality of Life activities was presented for council consideration. No action was taken.

Mr. Martin then made a motion to adjourn into Executive Session. The motion was seconded by Ms. Beiser. The motion carried unanimously.

After the Executive Session, Mr. Benson reported to those present that one matter of potential litigation and two real estate issues were discussed. No vote was taken on the three items.

Mr. Crow then made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ms. Smith. The motion carried unanimously.
