

Mayor Johnson called the Special Call meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. with all Council Members present.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Johnson called on Mr. Mickey Watts to explain the Pike Street Railroad Bridge Hanger and Gas Main Replacement Project. Mr. Watts explained that nine vendors received the bid package. The following vendors responded:

Hodge Enterprises	\$18,176.70
Pride Utility Construction Company	\$29,181.00
Benton Georgia	\$67,810.00

Mr. Watts asked the council to accept the low bidder. Mr. Watts informed the council that the bids had been solicited but not advertised. After some discussion, Mr. Powell made a motion to reject the bids and advertise the project. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Watts asked the council if it would be appropriate to extend their contract and issue a change order to Southern Cross Corporation for the 2011 leak survey. Mr. Watts stated that Southern Cross would do the work under their 2010 bid pricing. Mr. Watts also asked that the council extend the previous year's contract with Allied Corrosion Industries for their Cathodic Protection Services. Mr. Watts asked that the council approve this change order in an amount not to exceed \$39,500.00. After some discussion, Mr. Martin made a motion to extend the two contracts. The motion was seconded by Mr. Powell. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Powell presented a contract with Kimley Horn to perform a study on the mid-block pedestrian crossing near the intersection of Chestnut and Crogan Streets. Mr. Billew stated that he would like to have the contract broken down in the four phases not to exceed \$19,000.00 for all four phases. Mr. Powell asked that this work be on the City's contract form. Ms. Beiser made a motion to proceed with the pedestrian crosswalk study. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit File)

There being no further business, Ms. Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Martin. The motion carried unanimously.
