**NOTICE OF BID
FOR
Park Place Pedestrian Safety Improvement Project
SB003-17**

The City of Lawrenceville is soliciting competitive sealed bids from **Pre-Qualified** Gwinnett County DWR CIP Contractors for the **Park Place Pedestrian Safety Improvement Project**. Sealed bids will be received by the Lawrenceville Purchasing Office, 70 S. Clayton Street, Lawrenceville, Georgia 30046 until **3:00 P.M. local time on Wednesday, November 30, 2016** and then publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid received after 3:00 P.M. will not be accepted. Bid envelope should be marked on the outside with Bid Number, name of Bidder, date and time of opening. One unbound original and two (2) copies should be submitted.

The work to be performed by the Contractor consists of but is not limited to the following major items:

1. Site clearing, grading, excavation of existing pavement, demolition of existing concrete driveway entrances and drainage pipe and structures necessary for the installation of 2130 square yards of 3000 psi concrete for driveways, 8800 lf of 24" curb & gutter, 640 lf of header curb, 2570 tons of graded aggregate base, 1160 tons of 9.5 mm superpave asphaltic concrete 1.5" thick, 12,820 square yards of asphalt milling with a variable depth of 0 to 6 inches, and 300 cubic yards of 3000 psi Type "B" concrete for pavement support;
2. Installation (including trenching, bedding, backfilling and pavement saw cutting) of 219 linear feet of 36" High Density Polyethylene Pipe (HDPE), 194 linear feet of 30" HDPE, 47 linear feet of 24" HDPE, 2735 linear feet of 18" HDPE, 186 linear feet 24" Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP), 559 linear feet 18" RCP, construct 8 Storm Sewer Manholes, one doghouse manhole, 3 Pedestal Inlets With Hood, 7 Double Wing Catch Basins, 22 Single Wing Catch Basins, one 36" Flared End Section, one 30" Flared End Section and one 30" concrete headwall;
3. Installation of 4700 lf of 8" DIP Waterline, 200 lf of 6" DIP Waterline, install gate valves and other appurtenances, remove and reset fire hydrants, water meters, traffic signs and mailboxes, temporary seed and mulch disturbed areas as deemed necessary by the City Engineer, and place a final permanent layer of sod on all disturbed areas.

Questions regarding bids should be submitted to Steven Murray, Purchasing Manager, CPPB, via email at steve.murray@lawrencevillegaweb.org no later than 3:00 p.m. local time, Friday, March 11, 2016. Bids are legal and binding upon the bidder when submitted.

Bids in the case of Corporations not chartered in Georgia, must be accompanied by proper certification stating that said Corporation is authorized to do business in the State of Georgia.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within ninety (90) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Bidder agrees to complete the Contract awarded within the "allowable calendar days for completion" from the date of the "Notice to Proceed".

A five percent (5%) bid bond must be submitted with the bid. Successful contractor will be required to provide a one hundred percent (100%) payment and one hundred percent (100%) performance bond as well as an insurance certificate fulfilling requirements as stated in the bid documents. Surety and insurance companies must have an AM Best rating of A-5 or greater, be listed in the Federal Registry of Companies holding Certificate of Authority and acceptable sureties on Federal Bonds, be licensed by the Georgia Insurance Department and the Georgia Secretary of State to do business in the State of Georgia.

All bonds must be submitted on forms provided by the City of Lawrenceville and agencies providing bonds and insurance should provide proof that they meet the criteria outlined in the bid and contract documents.

The City of Lawrenceville does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission or access to its programs or activities. The written Bid Documents supersede any prior verbal or written communications between the parties.

Award will be made to the contractor submitting the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The City of Lawrenceville reserves the right to reject any or all bids to waive technicalities and to make an award deemed in its best interest. Bids may be split or awarded in entirety. The City reserves the option to negotiate terms, conditions and pricing with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder(s) at its discretion.

All companies submitting a bid will be notified in writing of award.
