



Residential Electric Rates

Monthly Service Charge:

- \$14.00

Non-summer residential rate (November to April):

- 0 – 650 kWh - \$0.074 per kWh
- 651 – 1,000 kWh - \$0.0710 per kWh
- >1,000 kWh - \$0.0690 per kWh

Summer residential rate (May to October):

- 0 – 650 kWh - \$0.079 per kWh
- 651 – 1,000 kWh - \$0.1010 per kWh
- >1,000 kWh - \$0.1120 per kWh

Residential Water Rates

A minimum of 2,000 gallons will be charged to each account each month.

- \$5.77 per 1,000 gallons

During “declared drought response level 4” which bans all outdoor water use and prohibits the customer from using the non-sewer meter, the minimum 2,000 gallons will not be charged for the non-sewer meter. However, if the non-sewer meter is used during the “drought response level 4” the meter will be locked off. A penalty of up to \$1,000.00 will be applied.

Multi-tiered water conservation surcharge rates will apply to all retail accounts for the billing in the months of June, July, August, September and October.

Residential Gas Rates

Monthly Service Charge:

- \$21.00

Per CCF (therm):

- \$0.40

Cost of Gas as set by the Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia:

- Varies monthly and is based on market conditions.

Commercial Electric Rates

Commercial Non-Demand

Monthly Service Charge:

- \$18.00

Non-summer Commercial rate (November to April):

- First 3,000 kWh - \$0.1125 per kWh
- >3,000 kWh - \$0.1025 per kWh

Summer Commercial rate (May to October):

- First 3,000 kWh - \$0.1325 per kWh
- >3,000 kWh - \$0.1225 per kWh

Commercial Small Power

- All consumption not greater than 200 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.1025 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 200 hours and not greater than 400 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0525 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 400 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0475 per kWh

Commercial Medium Power

- All consumption not greater than 200 hours times the billing demand
 - First 6,000 kWh - \$0.0925 per kWh
 - 6,000 kWh - \$0.0825 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 200 hours and not greater than 400 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0475 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 400 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0425 per kWh

Commercial Large Power

- All consumption not greater than 200 hours times the billing demand
 - First 100,000 kWh - \$0.0745 per kWh
 - > 100,000 kWh - \$0.0645 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 200 hours and not greater than 400 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0425 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 400 hours and not greater than 600 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0385 per kWh
- All consumption in excess of 600 hours times the billing demand
 - \$0.0345 per kWh

Commercial Water Rates

A minimum of 2,000 gallons will be charged to each account each month.

- \$6.82 per 1,000 gallons

During “declared drought response level 4” which bans all outdoor water use and prohibits the customer from using the non-sewer meter, the minimum 2,000 gallons will not be charged for the non-sewer meter. However, if the non-sewer meter is used during the “drought response level 4” the meter will be locked off. A penalty of up to \$1,000.00 will be applied.

Multi-tiered water conservation surcharge rates will apply to all retail accounts for the billing in the months of June, July, August, September and October.

Commercial Gas Rates

Monthly Service Charge:

- \$27.00

Per CCF (therm):

- \$0.40

Cost of Gas as set by the Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia:

- Varies monthly, and is based on market conditions.
